RE: The newly revised and expanded **JOHN Bible study course** (which includes eight bonus lessons and helps for Christian growth and service), purposed to reach the below-mentioned S.O.S. people groups).

This supplementary FREE course with extra helps is designed for pastors and members to broaden their vision in carrying out the Great Commission through the local church. There is a linking format that **gives purpose and direction to any member including the new convert and the one who seeks to disciple him or her.** Our John / Romans Salvation Bible study is used in the field to link to the John course. (This study can be found at kjvhearthelps.com, in the Christ-Like Caring in the Local Church Ministry Manual.)

Once the course on John is completed, it would be our recommendation that the courses Pauline Epistles I (Romans), Bible Doctrines, and Prayer be completed. Lessons One and Two of the Good Steward Financial Management Principles is included in the John course; it would be good for the new convert to also do Lessons Three (Budgeting) and Four (Getting Out of Major Debt), completing that course. **Our key desire here is to go from the world to the Word, to go from covetousness to contentment, and to go from misery to ministry.** Once these foundational courses are completed, there are more than 60 others to choose from, incorporating more than 1,000 Scripture memory verses, so that the believer can continue to grow in God's Word. (II Timothy 2:15)

Questions for our courses are taken directly from the King James Bible, and we really work at making the questions straight-forward, so that the answers are direct and easy to find. For this reason, there is no need for an answer key, or to return the courses to us. We recommend that the courses be saved for future review and reference. **Many churches present a Certificate of Achievement for each course that is completed.** Working at the rate of one course per month is a reasonable goal.

Our day-to-day outreach is called the S.O.S. Ministry, which encourages ministry to many people groups, including **Serving Our:** Savior, Souls, Shepherds (pastors /missionaries), Sunday Schools, Sister churches, Shut-ins, Solitary (including prison ministries), Spouses, Students, Soldiers and Sailors, Struggling, Sick and Suffering, Shattered, and Servants (civil: police, firefighters, mail carriers, politicians), etc. **The S.O.S. Ministry gives every local church member an opportunity to be involved in some way** (Matthew 25:35-40). These Biblical resources are designed to help those folks who desire to enlarge their ministry. The "Compelling Them to Come In ~ Tracking Grid" helps achieve an "each one reach one" mentality.
