A BRIEF NOTE ON HOW TO EFFECTIVELY BEGIN SCRIPTURE MEMORIZATION:

One of the simplest ways to memorize Scripture is to say a verse (or group of verses), with the reference, five times in the morning and five times in the evening for one week. At the end of one week, the verse should be committed to memory. Review that verse once a day to keep it fresh in your mind and begin saying the next week's verse(s) five times in the morning, etc. following the same procedure as before.

Try to actively incorporate the verses in day-to-day life and ministry. In Luke chapter four the Lord Jesus combats the devil's temptation by responding with specific Scriptures dealing with each temptation, which is so needed to overcome sins of the heart (Luke 4:4, 8, 12; I Corinthians 10:13). God is faithful to make a way of escape for every temptation we face. Hiding His Word in our hearts gives Him additional tools to use in giving us victory over sin.

Active in ministry ~ keeping their lives pure and hearts focused on the Word of God. (Psalm 119:11 - "Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.")
