**FAIR MINISTRIES** – Several hundred decisions for Christ have been reported at fair ministries across Ohio this summer. The George Nikitenko family (Amazing Grace Baptist Church) worked at a booth at the Cuyahoga County Fair and was used of the Lord to share the gospel message with many. They reported that folks were very open and interested in discussing spiritual things. Pastor Nikitenko dealt with a man named Robert, who left the fair still unsaved, but came back at the urgent request of a friend who had just gotten things right with the Lord. Robert then trusted Christ as his Savior, and left the fair the second time with his name written in heaven! At the Ohio State Fair, North Columbus Baptist Church (Pastor Dan Wolvin) assisted at a soulwinning booth with Amazing Grace Missions and reported approximately 150 decisions for Christ.

**COLLEGE CAMPUSES** – North Columbus Baptist Church also has an exciting ministry at the **Ohio State University** campus called “Buckeye Believers”, headed up by Associate Pastor Steve Wolvin. Specially designed tracts with OSU football schedules on the back are distributed to students. Brother Wolvin has Bible studies on the campus, and having “Buckeye Believers” officially recognized as a campus group gives them great opportunities to go soulwinning at OSU. In the five years they have had this ministry, approximately 100-120 students have trusted Christ. The church also provides a free meal monthly to OSU students who attend the morning service.

Broadview Heights Baptist Church (Pastor Don Barth, Jr.) is starting a new ministry at **Cleveland State University**. Diana and Pat LiBassi were delighted to be able to help two other BHBC members distribute information at CSU last week about the weekly Bible study scheduled to begin

on campus Friday evening, September 11<sup>th</sup>. (Pat first heard the gospel message and was saved while attending OSU.) Pass the word if you know any CSU students that may want to be part of this new ministry. CSU students not able to actually attend weekly meetings could still be of help in getting the Bible study started and having it recognized as a campus organization. Questions?
