SUPER-EASY PUMPKIN BREAD RECIPE – The smells and tastes of the fall season are so enjoyable. This delicious pumpkin bread recipe comes from our daughter, Laura Lindsey, and has **only two ingredients!** Diana has made it, and we both thought it was delicious. With a mixer, combine one spice cake mix (or use a yellow cake mix and add 1 teaspoon cinnamon and ½ teaspoon cloves), dry, with one 15 oz. can of pumpkin. Batter will be stiffer than usual. Bake muffins for 25 minutes or loaves for 35 minutes at 350 degrees. Since pumpkin is full of nutrients, and replaces the eggs and oil generally required for a cake mix, this bread has more of the "good stuff" and less fat and cholesterol! Enjoy, and have a wonderful, blessed Thanksgiving!
