We were aware of three folks calling on Christ for salvation, and numerous visitors were present in the various churches on Sunday morning. She just discovered that folks 50 or older who are members of AARP (\$16 per year) can purchase a prescription discount card (\$19.95 annually) that will save money on prescriptions at local pharmacies, and save even more if prescriptions for 90 days are ordered through the mail. Many of her Rx's were *significantly* cheaper! Also, for those of you who suffer or know someone who suffers with migraines, you may find this tip helpful. A friend of ours who has for years had terrible migraines was recently instructed by his doctor to increase his daily fiber intake. He takes one teaspoon of Metamucil in the morning, and another teaspoon at night, and has *really* seen an improvement!
