HELP AND HOPE FOR THE HURTING: BIBLICALLY OVERCOMING FEAR AND ANXIETY

“He maketh the storm a calm. . .” (Psalm 107:21-30)

1. Joshua 1:9 - Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good **courage**; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy **God is with thee** whithersoever thou goest. (Jeremiah 1:8; Philippians 4:13, 19)
2. Psalm 23:4 - Yea, though I walk **through** the valley of the shadow of death, I will **fear no evil**: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. (Psalm 100)
3. Psalm 27:1 - The LORD is my **light** and my **salvation**; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the **strength** of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? (Psalm 28:7)
4. Psalm 27:13-14 - I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the **goodness** of the LORD in the land of the living. **Wait** on the LORD: be of good **courage**, and he shall **strengthen thine heart**: wait, I say, on the LORD. (Psalm 37:3-7)
5. Psalm 51:10 - Create in me a **clean** heart, O God; and renew a **right** spirit within me. (Proverbs 16:32; 25:28)
6. Psalm 73:26 - My flesh and my heart faileth: but God is the **strength** of my heart, and my portion **for ever**. (Psalm 73:28)
7. Psalm 118:6 - The LORD is on **my** side; I will **not** fear: what can man do unto me? (Psalm 56:11)
8. Proverbs 3:24-25 - When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy **sleep** shall be **sweet**. **Be not afraid** of sudden fear, neither of the desolation of the wicked, when it cometh. (Psalm 4:8)
9. Isaiah 26:3 - Thou wilt keep him in perfect **peace**, whose mind is **stayed** on thee: because he **trusteth** in thee. (I John 4:18)
10. Isaiah 40:31 - But they that wait upon the LORD shall **renew their strength**; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall **run**, and **not be weary**; and they shall **walk**, and **not faint**. (Psalm 33:18-22)
11. Isaiah 41:10 - Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not **dismayed**; for I am thy God: I will **strengthen** thee; yea, I will **help** thee; yea, I will **uphold** thee with the right hand of my righteousness. (Psalm 121:1-2)
12. Nahum 1:7 - The LORD is **good**, a **strong hold** in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that **trust** in him. (Psalm 46:1; I Peter 1:6-7)
13. Matthew 11:28-30 - **Come** unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you **rest**. Take my yoke upon you, and **learn of me**; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is **easy**, and my burden is **light**. (II Corinthians 4:14-18)
14. John 14:1-3; 27 - Let not your **heart** be **troubled**: ye **believe in God**, believe **also in me**. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. Peace I leave with you, **my peace I give unto you**: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. (Eternal security verses - John 1:12; 3:16-17, 36; 5:24; 6:37; 10:28; 20:31)

15. John 16:33 - These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good **cheer**; I have **overcome** the world. (Mark 4:35-41)
16. Romans 5:1 - Therefore being justified by **faith**, we have **peace** with God **through our Lord Jesus Christ**: Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death; but the **gift** of God is eternal life **through Jesus Christ our Lord**. (Romans 3:23-24, 6:23, 5:8-9, 10:9-10, 13) Trusting the Lord Jesus is the key to true peace!
17. Romans 8:38-39 - For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, **nor any other creature**, shall be able to **separate us from the love of God**, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Ephesians 3:17-21)
18. Philippians 4:6-7 - Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by **prayer** and **supplication** with **thanksgiving** let your **requests** be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. (I Thessalonians 5:16-18)
19. II Timothy 1:7 - For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of **power**, and of **love**, and of a **sound mind**. (Romans 8:31-32)
20. II Corinthians 1:3-4 - Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of **all** comfort; Who **comforteth** us in **all** our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in **any trouble**, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God. (II Corinthians 8:9; 12:9)
21. Hebrews 4:16 - Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain **mercy**, and find **grace to help in time of need**. (Psalm 34:4-6)
22. Hebrews 13:5-6 - Let your conversation be without covetousness; and **be content** with such things as ye have: for he hath said, **I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee**. So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and **I will not fear** what man shall do unto me. (Psalm 118:24)
23. I Peter 5:7 - Casting **all** your care upon him; for **he careth for you**. (Jeremiah 33:3)
24. I John 4:4 - Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because **greater** is he that is **in** you, than he that is in the world. (I John 5:4)
25. Hebrews 4:2 - For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached **did not profit** them, **not being mixed with faith** in them that heard it. (Hebrews 11:6)
